

Partner Reading, Paragraph Shrinking Protocol

Adapted from Burns et al. (2015), Preast et al. (2020), and PALS (Fuchs et al., 2001)

Before beginning intervention,

- 1. Sort automaticity scores from lowest to highest based on fluency data
- 2. Find the median number and break the class in half.
- 3. Match the top reader in the lower half with the top reader in the upper half.
- 4. Find texts at Reader 2's instructional fluency level.

Note: Each step of this protocol takes 5 minutes each totaling 20 minutes daily.

Reader 1	Reader 2
Pick up the folder.	Find a place to work.
Read text for 5 minutes.	Listen and follow along.
	That word is What is the word? Now go back & read that sentence again.
Listen and follow along.	Read the same text for 5 minutes.

Read new text for 5 minutes.	Listen and follow along.
After every paragraph, shrink: Most important who? Most important what? Main idea in 10 words or less.	Error correct as necessary.
Listen and follow along.	Read new text for 5 minutes.
Error correct as necessary.	After every paragraph, shrink: Most important who? Most important what? Main idea in 10 words or less.



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
